
Welcome to the Movie Monday Film Collection, a catalogue of select films previously featured in Victoria's Movie Monday programme and made available to the public through Yo Video.

In this collection you will find many of the films that have engaged Movie Monday audiences. We think it is a reliable yet eclectic mix of films that will entertain and provoke thoughtful discussion. This collection includes films presenting challenging themes on important community issues – many are focused on issues related to mental illness and recovery. As an alternative to the mainstream, our films often explore issues of marginalization and seek to reduce stigma..

And some films are just great fun...because that's important too!!

Lots in this collection are "homemade", local and Canadian titles, that don't make it to the cineplex, don't stay long, or are video format so never shown in theatres. Often these films are tricky to track down after you've seen them at MM or noticed them in our schedule. Many are not viable in most video store collections but are 'tried and true' at MM, films that deserve to be seen.

Some titles have public performance licenses so that they may be show in non-charge public screenings (marked PPL). Others are for home viewing only and permission should be sought from rights holders for educational or public showing.
